

## Capable 21C current enhancements

- 29/8/05 1.5.309 Corrected a defect in the Setup of Document Types such that when an existing document properties window is opened, the 'Edit Document' button is appropriately enabled or disabled. The button will be disabled now only if the document does not exist.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Enhanced the appointment book print out so that it can print all practitioners on a single page. Note that if a practitioner is overbooked, the appointment may not appear (just as it may not appear on the on-screen appointment book).
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Enhanced the patient/client tracking window so that it is slightly wider, and so that when reminders are viewed, Capable 21C displays both the date of the next visit and the time of the next visit.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Corrected a defect in Patient Information and Editing and also in Patient Details that would produce spurious runtime errors if a double quote (") was included in a patient surname, or accidentally keyed in the search criteria. A double quote mark is a special symbol used by the underlying database engine, and if included in a name, it can produce unpredictable behaviour from the database engine. This fix simply removes any instance of a double quote from the patient surname or first name when they are keyed either in Patient Information and Editing, or in Patient Details.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Corrected a defect whereby appointments made via the scheduling window would appear in the appointment book using the patient/client's 'real' first name rather than their preferred salutation. This correction ensures that appointments made using the schedule window will use the correct patient/client salutation, just as appointments made through the Patient Information and Editing window. Note that the patient salutations will only be used in either scenario if they are enabled via the Setup| Settings window on the General tab.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Altered the behaviour of Setup Appointment Types and Fees such that when new appointment types are added, appointment type names are altered, or when appointment types are deleted, the associated menus for making and changing appointments are also automatically updated. In the past, these menus would only update when Capable 21C was next started.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Altered the behaviour of the 'Make Next Appt' button on the normal receipt window. Some customers have reported that when they click the Make Next Appt button, sometimes the To Do List is displayed in front of the appointment book. This fix ensures that the appointment book is brought to the front whenever the operator clicks on the 'Make Next Appt' button during receipting.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Altered the behaviour of the end of week reports window so that transfer of data for advanced statistical reporting cannot be enabled unless the weekly financial reports are printed. Testing has revealed that if the weekly financial reports are not printed, then the figures transferred for advanced statistical reports are not reliably accurate. The new behaviour of the weekly reports window ensures that the transfer cannot be requested unless the weekly reports have been selected.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Corrected a defect with the way that Capable 21C handles permanent notes during receipting. If the operator opens the receipt, and then clicks the red X on the permanent notes window, Capable 21C would delete the permanent notes and replace them with the words 'Permanent Notes'. This defect has been corrected by removing the red X entirely. Special thanks to Kouxan Natural Health for their patience and help in locating and eliminating this defect.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Corrected a defect with the way that Capable 21C records Visit Notes. If the operator clicks the red X to close the window, Capable 21C would fail to record the Visit Notes completely. This correction ensures that the notes are recorded correctly no matter how the window is closed.
- 28/8/05 1.5.308 Altered the way that Capable 21C interacts with Microsoft Access to produce clinical findings forms. This should produce more reliable results in printing the forms, and help to eliminate a spurious error that reports that Microsoft Access is not installed when it actually is installed.
- 24/8/05 1.5.307 Altered the way that Capable 21C opens the Visits and Financials window so that it is always brought to the front. A number of clients have reported that when they click the Visits & Financials button, that nothing appears to happen. This can occur if the Visits & Financials window is already open, but hidden behind the appointment book. Clicking the Visits & Financials window moves the focus (eg the cursor) onto the (already open) Visits & Financials window, but can leave the window still hidden behind the appointment book. This change ensures that the Visits & Financials window is always brought to the front of the appointment book.
- 24/8/05 1.5.307 Corrected a defect in the practitioner shift time setup screens that would remove block outs from a practitioner's

calendar when the practitioner's shift times were changed. The system now functions correctly according to the following details: When a practitioner shift times are changed, Capable will prompt to update the appointment book. If the operator directs Capable 21C to continue, it will remove all 'Outside Hours' appointments. These include the grey areas before the start of the day, after the end of the day and lunch breaks. Block outs will not be altered. The practitioner's defined holidays will not be altered. Capable 21C will also prompt the operator to decide whether they want any public holidays to be updated. If the operator directs Capable 21 to continue, it will remove and re-instate any public holidays that have been defined for the office as a whole. Note that historically, shifts that were closed by an operator (eg by right clicking and choosing the option to Close the Shift), were incorrectly closed by creating an 'Outside Hours' appointment. Unfortunately, this means that any shifts that have already been closed will still be removed the first time that practitioners are altered. This correction will also ensure that any future shifts that are closed will be closed with a 'Block Out' instead - thereby ensuring that those closed shifts are not inadvertently re-opened when practitioner shift times are altered.

- 23/8/05 1.5.306 Enhanced the debtors summary window such that any printed summary only reflects the filtered list of debtors selected. Also introduced the concept of a date picker for the first time in Capable 21C. Selecting dates in the debtors summary window is now much easier.
- 23/8/05 1.5.306 Corrected a defect in Setup|Settings whereby if the operator turned educational classes on or off, the educational class window would not appear immediately. The educational classes window will now appear (or disappear) as soon as the Setup|Settings are applied.
- 22/8/05 1.5.305 Enhanced the configuration of appointment durations (under Setup|Setup Practitioners) so that a delay value can be included. This allows appointments to be made where the patient/client's name appears at one time, and the subsequent blocked out slots do not appear immediately after the name, but rather after a short delay. This feature is particularly useful if patient/clients are asked to arrive half an hour before they will consume time from the practitioner's appointment book. The example that triggered this feature enhancement was one where new patients are asked to arrive at 9am (for example), spend half an hour seeing a video and completing their forms, and then they see the practitioner at 9:30am. To enable this feature, create an appointment type for appointments with a delay. Then go to Setup|Setup Practitioners (or Setup|whatever you have named your practitioners) select Appointment Timing, double click on the duration box for the appointment type with the delay, enter the number of slots to block out for that kind of appointment, then double click on the delay box for that type of appointment and enter the number of slots to block out before the practitioner will actually be seeing the patient/client.
- 8/8/05 1.5.304 Corrected a defect related to the way that Capable 21C calculates the date of next appointment on printed receipts. Capable 21C would incorrectly assume that the next appointment is the first one it finds on the next date that the patient/client is booked into the office. However, if there are two appointments on the same day, Capable 21C would accept either of these as the next appointment, which was sometimes incorrect.
- 8/8/05 1.5.304 Enhanced the schedule making functionality so that if an appointment is about to be booked on a day and time that is fully booked, Capable 21C will now prompt the operator giving them the option to make the appointment at another time.
- 5/8/05 1.5.303 Enhanced the statement printing functionality with two new special options for statement designs. These are the Insurer's Address for Private Patients and Insurer for Private Patients. These are intended to be used for Western Australian clients who wish to produce Motor Vehicle Accident Insurance Statements using the private statement style (eg start and end date with all transactions during the period) but need the statements to be addressed to the insurer instead of the patient. The setup for these kinds of statements is complex, and a series of instructions is available in the form of a knowledgebase article. - 5/8/05 1.5.302 Corrected a defect in the receipt handling code that would produce a runtime error 94 (Invalid use of Null) if a receipt is saved with no services and no change to the defaulted payment method. This runtime error should no longer occur.
- 5/8/05 1.5.302 Corrected a defect in the appointment book whereby if an appointment is dragged to another date and dropped on that date, the colour of the number of the day goes blue and remains blue. Whilst this is not a significant issue for most days, for the current date, the background is also blue, and this makes the number unreadable. The correction ensures that the colour of the day number returns to its original colour when an appointment is dropped onto it.
- 5/8/05 1.5.302 Enhanced the cancellation list so that when an name is dragged from the cancellation list to the appointment book, and then the activity of creating an appointment is cancelled, the name is not removed from the cancellation list.
- 5/8/05 1.5.302 Corrected a defect in the patient/client search feature whereby new patient/client files that do not have an address key yet did not appear correctly.

- 4/8/05 1.5.301 Corrected a defect with the SMS Messaging Service that would produce a runtime error 13 if the return phone number (configured in Setup|SMS Settings) was purely numerical. With this correction in place, the return number can be either numerical or alpha-numeric.
- 3/8/05 1.5.300 Corrected a defect with the Multi Doctor View that would conceal the first appointment on a row that immediately followed a row that was overbooked one slot beyond the configured number of columns on the appointment book. This correction will ensure that appointments are not artificially concealed by the appointment book.
- 2/8/05 1.5.299 Enhanced the appointment book to support a cancellation list. With this feature, patient/client files can be dragged and dropped onto the cancellation list, or added via patient/client information and editing. Once on the cancellation list, the patient/ client name will be visible to the operators whenever the desired practitioner is selected. When the Multi Doctor View is enabled, all desired cancellations for the day will be visible. Patients/Clients on the cancellation list can be appointed by dragging them to the desired slot on the appointment book. This will automatically remove them from the cancellation list. When patients/clients are dragged from the appointment book onto the cancellation list, Capable 21C will prompt whether the operator wishes to remove or retain the appointment that is being dragged to the cancellation list. This can be an easy way to add patients/clients to the cancellation list.
- 1/8/05 1.5.299 Corrected a defect in the Patient/Client search screen, whereby if an operator scrolls slowly down to the very last patient/client, their address is duplicated in the blank rows after the last patient/client. The correction ensures that the addresses are blank if the patient/client name is blank.
- 29/7/05 1.5.299 Fixed a defect in the 'Bulk Payment on another day' feature. If a family payment was selected, Capable 21C would post the credit component of the family payment on the date nominated by the operator, but it would post the debit component (on the other family member) on today's date regardless. This has now been fixed so that the debit component is posted on the same date as the credit.
- 28/7/05 1.5.298 Corrected a long standing defect in the printed appointment book that the first appointment of the shift would not always print. This defect was first reported several years ago and has never been able to be replicated in Capable Software's test labs. Special thanks go to the staff at Brisbane Network Chiropractic for providing a sample database that could reliably reproduce the fault.
- 28/7/05 1.5.297 Corrected a defect in the Multi Doctor View of the appointment book whereby it would display shading in the appointment book according to the practitioner's name that was highlighted at the top of the appointment book view. Now, in Multi Doctor View, shading appears correctly for each practitioner visible.
- 28/7/05 1.5.296 Enhanced the SMS Messaging interface for Streetdata so that if the operator sets up a dialback number (in Setup|Setup SMS Messaging), all SMSes sent by Capable 21C will appear to have been sent by that number. This will prevent SMSes sent by Capable 21C appearing on the target mobile phone as 'from Streetdata'.
- 27/7/05 1.5.295 Enhanced the appointment book such that the message 'Receipt will be put into the next shift' no longer appears if an operator accidentally left clicks on a block out when the shift is closed.
- 27/7/05 1.5.295 Corrected a defect in the appointment book that would hide the first practitioner's name if both the Multi Doctor View and the Locations feature are enabled together.
- 27/7/05 1.5.295 Enhanced the receipting/invoicing code such that it is more robust and does not produce a runtime error 94 when corrupt data is present for the appointment types and valid services for those appointment types. This error would only occur when a new invoice is started for an appointment type that has no valid services attached to it.

\*\*\*\*\*CRITICAL UPDATE\*\*\*\*\*

- v1.5.294 Note that a new feature has been added to the appointment book in v1.5.294. It is now possible to place the appointment book in 'Multi Doctor View' which will show all practitioners on the appointment book at the same time. However, there are limitations with this new feature, and it should be enabled with care. See below for more details.
- 27/7/05 1.5.294 Capable 21C can now be switched into Multi-Doctor View mode. This mode alters the appearance of the appointment book so that all practitioners/service providers can be seen side by side. This feature can be enabled in Setup|Settings on the Appointment Book tab. Note that in Multi Doctor View, Capable 21C will only display the number of columns defined for the practitioner (in Setup|Setup Practitioner Details). If the practitioner has been double booked or overbooked, additional appointments cannot be displayed as there are no longer any spare columns on the appointment book. In these cases, overbooked appointments will be pushed down the appointment book.
- 27/7/05 1.5.294 Capable 21C now supports up to 30 columns on the appointment book. Displaying so many columns may be

unwieldy for some offices, and the number of columns displayed should be tempered by the operator giving consideration to screen size and resolution. The number of columns may be altered from Setup|Settings on the Appointment Book tab.

- 27/7/05 1.5.294 Capable 21C will now detect appointments that are moved into block outs, or are made in times that are blocked out (or outside of business hours). Capable 21C will prompt the operator to confirm that they wish to make (or move) the appointment if this occurs. If the new Multi Doctor View is enabled, Capable 21C will not allow the operator to move an appointment into a blocked out time at all. This feature can be enabled from the Setup|Settings window under the appointment book tab.
- 27/7/05 1.5.294 Corrected a defect in the Debtors Summary report that was inadvertently introduced in v1.5.288. This defect causes the printed summary of debtors to exclude transactions that occurred before the 'Date of Last Statement run'. The correction ensures that all historical patient/client visits are included to ensure correct balances.
- 26/7/05 1.5.294 Corrected a defect in the Patient/Client Details window that would allow the window to be maximised (to fill the entire screen). Once this window is maximised, if it is closed by clicking the 'Cancel' button, it leaves the appointment book maximised as well, effectively hiding the To Do List and any other windows that are also open. The fix disables the button that would normally be used to maximise the Patient/Client Details window.
- 26/7/05 1.5.294 Corrected a defect in v1.5.293 whereby Capable 21C would fail to refresh the appointment book immediately after an appointment was made. Whilst the appointment is made successfully, it would not visibly appear on the appointment book until after the defined refresh interval (which could be as long as an hour). This correction ensures that newly made appointments become visible immediately.
- 26/7/05 1.5.293 Enhanced the Capable 21C appointment book so that the interval of time between automatic refreshes of the appointment book can be varied above 60 seconds. By default, Capable 21C refreshes the display of the appointment book every 60 seconds. This way, appointments made on other computers in the network can be seen on all PCs. Historically, the interval between refreshes could be set in Setup|Settings on the Appointment Book tab. The value is measured in milliseconds (thousandths of a second) and defaults to 60000. This value can now be reduced as low as 2000 and increased as high as 6000000 (approximately one and a half hours). Offices that experience Out of Stack Space errors due to wireless network drop outs may get better stability by gradually increasing this number.
- 25/7/05 1.5.292 Enhanced the Word Document merging features to automatically deal with a security patch applied by Microsoft that prevents access to Mail Merged Word Documents from within Capable 21C. This only applies to MS Word 2002 and 2003. The net effect of the change is that users who are experiencing a problem whereby one off documents (normally accessed from patient/client details) that do not link correctly to the Capable 21C database will now be able to link. Refer to Microsoft Knowledgebase Article 825765 for a detailed description of the problem in Microsoft Word and the workaround implemented by Capable Software.
- 25/7/05 1.5.292 Corrected a defect in the practitioner setup screens that relates directly to recent enhancements for appointment locations.
- 25/7/05 1.5.291 Introduced a locations feature that allows locations to be assigned where practitioners can operate and have appointments booked. This feature has been exclusively developed to meet the needs of one particular client, and are not available for general use. Please contact Capable Software directly if more information is required about this feature.
- 18/7/05 1.5.290 Enhanced the Capable 21C appointment book so that if there is a large number of providers/doctors/practitioners, two or three rows of tabs will become visible for them. Capable 21C will automatically resize the rest of the appointment book so that the normal appointment slots appear properly. There should be no visible change for offices that have a small number of practitioners. Offices with a large number of practitioners may notice that the appointment book becomes significantly taller to accommodate for the extra tabs.
- 18/7/05 1.5.289 Capable 21C now supports a wheel mouse on the appointment book. It is now possible to scroll up and down the appointment book when it is the active form within Capable by scrolling the mouse wheel up and down.
- 17/7/05 1.5.288 Enhanced the SMS Messaging facility so that it automatically copes with leading or trailing spaces in the SMS Server Name, SMS Username or SMS Password. By default, Capable 21C starts with these values being a single space (eg ' '). If a user clicks in any of these boxes, and just types the correct value, the space is left behind and prevents correct operation of the SMS Messaging facility. Capable 21C has now been enhanced to automatically trim off any leading or trailing spaces to ensure correct operation of SMS Messaging. A Test button has also been added to the SMS Messaging Setup window to facilitate easy testing of the feature.

- 17/7/05 1.5.288 Corrected a defect in the Debtors Summary report in that it would not print with a closing date that reflected the closing date selected on the Debtors window. Capable 21C will now print debtors summaries that accurately reflect the closing date nominated.
- 14/7/05 1.5.287 Enhanced the update code that handles the v1.5.280 update so that it automatically corrects possible database damage. This will prevent an 'unhandleable error' for clients who have database damage.
- 12/7/05 1.5.286 The Patient Visit Listings/Visit Notes feature has now been released for open beta testing. Only customers on the Beta Program will be able to access this feature at this point in time. Detailed information and instructions will be forthcoming when this feature is released to all customers.
- 11/7/05 1.5.286 Enhanced the reminder date code further to ensure that the reminder date lead time specified in Setup|Settings is applied more consistently throughout the system.
- 11/7/05 1.5.285 Corrected a defect in the reminder code that would generate a runtime error if no appointments had been yet made for a patient who likes reminders.
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the way that Capable 21C handles permanent notes when two invoice/receipts are open concurrently. The defect would allow Capable 21C to confuse which notes belong to which patient/client file if a very specific sequence of mouse clicks was performed. The fix involves attaching a different permanent notes window to each open receipt, and all may be viewed concurrently. However, when any receipt is brought to the front and actioned, its associated permanent notes window will also be brought to the front. The title bar of each permanent notes window is the name of the patient/client, and should prevent confusion or mis-entry from occurring.
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the way that the appointment book refreshes after a change in Patient/Client Details. If a name is changed in Patient/Client Details, the appointment book would not reflect that changed name until either it was moved away (and back again), or until its regular 60 second refresh occurred. This could be confusing for an operator who changes a patient/client name and does not see an immediate change in the appointment book. This fix forces the appointment book to update and reflect the change as soon as the Patient/Client Details window is closed.
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the way that Capable 21C set reminder dates for upcoming visits. Once Capable 21C had assigned a reminder to a patient/client file, it would automatically re-assign that reminder when another appointment was made. If three appointments were made in a row (not using the scheduling feature), Capable 21C would assign the reminder to the third of these regardless of whether it was the soonest of the three. This fix now forces Capable 21C to set the reminder to the earliest appointment in the future unless the scheduling feature is used (when the reminder date is set explicitly by the operator).
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the appointment properties window that would allow it to become hidden behind the appointment book. Once the appointment properties window is opened (right click on an appointment and choose properties), it was possible to click elsewhere on the appointment book without closing the appointment properties window. If this was done, and another appointment's properties were requested, the appointment properties window would not be brought back in front of the appointment book, giving the appearance that the appointment properties feature was not working. This has now been corrected so that the appointment properties window will always be brought to the front when requested.
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the appointment book in that the blue box that indicates today's date would not move to the new date if Capable 21C was left running overnight (or past midnight). The correction means that Capable 21C will confirm today's date and show today's date as a blue box on the appointment book. Note that this correction also means that if the system date is changed (by double-clicking on the clock in the system tray), Capable 21C will update to reflect the newly chosen date. Note also that Capable 21C automatically refreshes the appointment book every 60 seconds, so a change in the date may not be reflected by the appointment book for up to 60 seconds after the date has changed.
- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the way that Capable 21C handles appointment book shading when a practitioner is deleted from the system. In the past, Capable 21C would attach shading to a practitioner's numerical position on the appointment book rather than their name. This defect was fixed in v1.5.236, and in subsequent versions, the colouration was attached to the practitioner's name rather than their number. However, when a practitioner was deleted, the old records remained, and became attached to the practitioner that assumed the new numerical position on the appointment book. For example if you deleted the first practitioner, their colouration would become attached to the practitioner that become the new first practitioner. This correction fixes that defect such that when a practitioner is deleted, the colouration that was configured for them is also deleted and not attached to any other practitioner.

- 10/7/05 1.5.284 Corrected a defect in the way that Capable 21C prints schedules so that it can accurately print schedules with two or more visits in a single day. In the past, Capable 21C would only print the time of the later of the two visits in the short (3 month) format schedule. Now, Capable 21C will print the times of all appointments when it prints a short schedule.
- 8/7/05 1.5.283 Corrected a defect in the appointment book printout code to ensure that any appointments that have been confirmed are printed in the font defined in Setup|Setup Appointment Book Appearance.
- 7/7/05 1.5.282 Corrected a defect in the appointment book code that would cause the menu of available appointment types to grey out extra appointment types incorrectly. The only effect of this correction is that the menu of available appointment types should display correctly.
- 4/7/05 1.5.281 Corrected a defect in the appointment book code that would allow appointment types to be changed to those that are not valid for the practitioner. Each practitioner has durations configured for each appointment type. By configuring a practitioner's duration to be zero (0), an appointment type may be disabled for that practitioner. Until now, that disabling ability operated correctly when making new appointments, but not when attempting to change the type of an existing appointment. This correction will disable and enable appointment types appropriately on the 'Change Appointment Type' sub-menu that appears when you right click on an appointment on the appointment book. Prior to this correction, appointment types would be disabled and enabled incorrectly.
- 30/6/05 1.5.280 Enhanced the To Do List such that a new kind of Task can be created that lists all patient/client visits in the last week where Visit Notes have not been captured.
- 30/6/05 1.5.280 Completed the Beta Version of the Patient/Client Visit Notes recording feature for straight Chiropractic only. This feature will be enabled for all customers once the beta program has completed.
- 30/6/05 1.5.280 Enhanced the shift open/shift close feature so that when a shift is closed, it is possible to nominate a practitioner to move existing appointments to. If a practitioner is nominated, all appointments for the practitioner whose shift is being closed will be moved across to the other practitioner. This functionality only takes effect if a shift is being closed. It is also only available if more than one practitioner has been configured in the system.
- 30/6/05 1.5.280 Corrected a defect in the appointment book printout code that would occasionally make appointments print out appearing to overlap half way between one row and the next. The correction ensures that appointments print neatly on the row of the printed appointment book. There should be no other noticeable change from this correction.
- 30/6/05 1.5.280 Enhanced the patient/client tracking windows such that any letters produced will be printed in alphabetical order (by surname). There should be no other noticeable change from this enhancement.
- 23/6/05 1.5.279 Enhanced the appointment book so that it no longer produces a runtime error 9 Subscript out of range when the appointment book is configured to open till 11pm at night, and is setup for 10 minute slots. The only effect of this enhancement is that the runtime error will no longer occur.
- 22/6/05 1.5.278 Enhanced the prepayment feature in Visits and Financials to allow the operator to select the service that will be used for the re-evaluation charge, and also the service that will be discounted by prepayment. This allows Capable to set the prepayment discount service charge accurately in light of the recently added Defined Fees feature. Operators will notice that the prepayment window has two new fields that allow them to select the re-evaluation service and the normal prepaid service. This enhancement also corrects a defect that would produce a runtime error when a prepayment was processed this way.
- 21/6/05 1.5.278 Corrected a defect in the image viewer that would truncate long patient case numbers. This will allow the entire case number to be seen on the image viewer.
- 20/6/05 1.5.278 Capable now supports patient classifications for fee calculation. This new feature allows each patient to be classified as 'Normal Fee', 'Student', 'Pensioner', etc. Once so classified, the default fees that appear on invoices will be affected by the classification. By default, this feature is disabled, and Capable 21C will continue to function as it always has in the past. To enable the feature, go to Setup|Settings, and tick the box on the Receipts tab to Enable Patient/Client Classifications. Capable 21C will use the following procedure to determine fees for all products and services:
1. Check the patient/client classification.
  2. Lookup the fee for the service that matches that classification.
  3. Check to see if the patient/client has a special (defined) fee set.
  4. If so, override the fee determined in step 2 with the special (defined) fee.

5. Check to see if the patient/client is an insurance patient/client.
6. If so, override the fee determined in step 4 with the Insurance Fee.

By default, all files start with the classification 'Normal Fee', which should mean no change to the existing fees defined in current systems.

- 17/6/05 1.5.278 Corrected the background colours on the office details window.

The correction forces Capable 21C to use the correct time for today's cash up even if a receipt has been accidentally posted after the cash up from the previous day.
